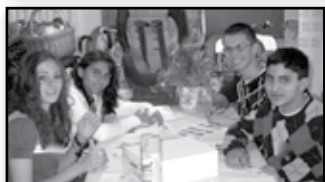


## Teens Get Involved With ZOE

We were very happy to welcome some of the participants of the Antiochian Midwest Soyo Meeting, which took place in Cleveland last October. Twenty-two young people came to ZOE House to enthusiastically volunteer their time assisting with organizing and maintenance projects. They saw in very concrete ways where the church stands on the issue of life, and how we work with



women in crisis pregnancies, enabling them to maintain their pregnancies and parent their children. They had questions about how ZOE functions, discussed adoption possibilities and witnessed first hand how decisions made today can affect their tomorrows.



# Bishop Daniel Meets With Zoe for Life Staff!



On Wednesday, April 21, 2010, His Grace Bishop Daniel met with the representatives of ZOE for Life!, in Parma, OH.

ZOE for Life! is a non-profit Christ-centered support organization with three major goals: to help women in crisis pregnancy, to assist Orthodox Christian couples seeking to adopt, and to create an Orthodox Christian Pure Living program to educate young people. The organization is endorsed by the Standing Conference of the Canonical Orthodox Bishops in the Americas.

Paula Kappos, President of ZOE for Life! presented the Bishop with a summary of the organization's ministry, stating that "Many women in crisis pregnancies wrestle with abortion, some with adoption and some with suicide. To encourage women to carry their infants to term, ZOE for Life! offers emotional and spiritual support, confidential access to professional agencies, and connections to potential adoptive Orthodox Christian families."

His Grace was escorted to the meeting by the pastor of St. Vladimir Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral in Parma,

OH, Very Rev. Fr. John Nakonachny and Protodeacon Ihor Mahlay. Bishop Daniel toured ZOE House, and then gathered with those present for a candid discussion with regard to ZOE's history, the function of ZOE House, as well as the goals and aspirations of this life endorsing mission. His Grace felt strongly that more could be accomplished if ZOE for Life! were brought to the forefront of Orthodoxy in America. All agreed that the good things that are happening here would hearten the faithful. As has happened at ZOE House in Cleveland, our Orthodox young people see first hand the impact this mission has on His children in need. It confirms for them precisely where their church stands on this issue, and encourages them to consider the long-term ramifications of actions they might feel societal pressure to participate in today.

Talking with Kathy Kovalak, Executive Director of ZOE House, Iryna Mahlay, Board Member, and Paula Kappos, the Bishop offered specific suggestions to assist ZOE for Life! in taking the next step toward greater national recognition. His exhortation to do so by devising a plan to enable the faithful in other cities across America to replicate what has been done in Cleveland was startling in its clarity and simplicity. We gratefully accepted his generosity of spirit in making the time in his busy schedule to see first hand what is being accomplished here, as well as for his blessing for the work being done.
